About MT MARSHALL

The Shire of Mt Marshall is located deep in the heart of Australia's Golden Outback, an easy three hours' drive northeast of Perth in WA's Wheatbelt region. Its rich agricultural lands, nurtured generation after generation, have crafted the region's proud pioneering legacy and laid strong foundations for the future. In a historic tribute to the region's first settlers and once-thriving sandalwood industry the Shire of Mt Marshall was officially named The Sandalwood Shire in February 2007.

The two major towns Bencubbin, and nearby Beacon, are active, safe and vibrant communities with excellent sporting facilities and a remarkable community spirit. Home to some 500 local residents, families living in the Shire of Mt Marshall enjoy a relaxed, country lifestyle that encourages everyone to get involved.

From June to November, the natural landscape is transformed into technicoloured tapestry as the region's famed "carpet of colour" comes into full bloom. It is also a great place to take a trip back in time and visit the remains of centuries old homesteads, sheep yards and watering wells.

Things to see & do in the Shire

Marshall Rock - a short drive out of Bencubbin with 360 degree views of surrounding farmland from the top.

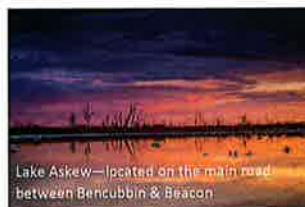
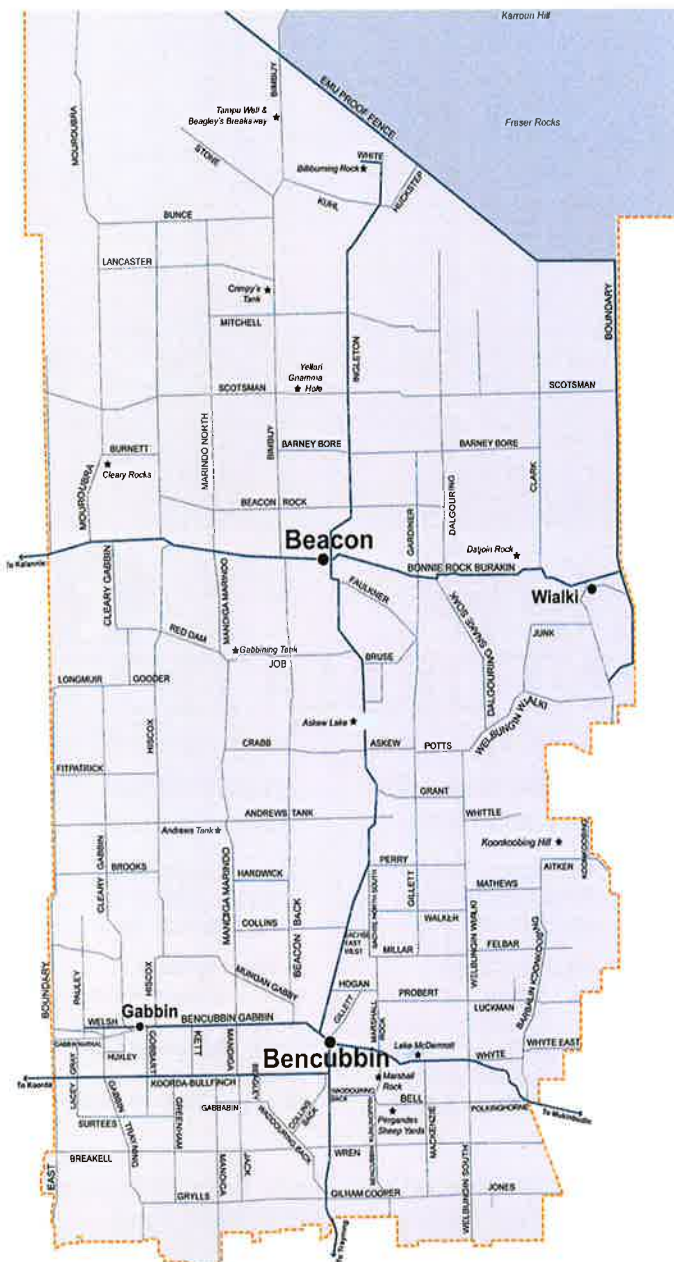
Pergande Sheep Yards - the remains of an original and prominent homestead and sheep yards that were constructed almost entirely from local granite. A great insight into how the early settlers lived.

Sandalwood Dray - Located on Monger Street in Bencubbin, next to the Community Resource Centre.

Lake Askew - A salt lake located between Bencubbin & Beacon offers magical photography opportunities.

Billiburning Rock - situated in the North-East of the Shire near the vermin proof fence. This rock is part of quite a large natural forest reserve, it is one of the largest outcrops in the area and provides many opportunities for birdwatchers

Datjoin Well & Rock Reserve - During the winter and spring months, Datjoin Reserve is a popular picnic and tourist camp spot for those looking to find some of the best orchids and wildflowers in the region.
