

THINGS TO DO AND SEE

Entrance to Corrigin

The Corrigin Townscape Committee has created two uniquely Corrigin entry statements indicative to the district—a windmill, water tank, trough, post and rail fence and native plants. These are located either side of town on the Brookton Highway.

Dog Cemetery

Whilst in Corrigin, you may like to visit the Dog Cemetery. Established in 1974, the Dog Cemetery is a tribute to "Mans Best Friend". With over 80 loved ones now buried, the cemetery is unique to Corrigin. Take time to read some of the headstones, which are all made and maintained by a local resident. Located 5kms out of town on the Brookton Highway, the cemetery is land marked by a statue of a large dog. Any person is welcome to bury their dog at the cemetery & many have traveled from different towns to lay pets in their final resting place.

Scenic Lookouts

RSL Lookout and The Scenic Lookout provide ideal photo opportunities of the various views including the town site, salmon gums and farmlands. There is a World War I Turkish Mountain Gun at the RSL Lookout.

Gorge Rock

Located 23kms SE of town, Gorge Rock has a natural rock pool which was once the local swimming hole. Swimming is not permitted now but a walk to the top reveals panoramic views of surrounding farmland and provides a good rest stop, with natural bushland making pleasant surroundings.

Dam Bush Track

Take a walk on this peaceful, level, short track meandering through natural bush. The track has a sheltered picnic table, is signed along the way with points of interest and begins near the water tower.

Bullaring

Located to the SW of Corrigin, Bullaring has an old time original well, a general store, wheat bins, wildflowers & natural woodlands.

Agricultural Show and Dyson Jones Corrigin Shears

Held early in September, the Agricultural Show is full of wonderful things to see, from huge modern farm machinery, local crafts, fashion parades & farm animals to sheaf tossing competitions. The Dyson Jones Corrigin Shears Competition is an exciting all-day event for talented shearers from across the country. A great day out for the whole family.

Dog in a Ute

The Dog in a Ute event involves the coming together of two great rural Aussie icons - the 'Ute' & Man's Best Friend, the 'Dog' in an attempt to break a World Record, raise funds to donate back into the community & other organizations, encourage visitors & provide recognition to Rural WA to boost our profile. Corrigin currently holds the world record (1527) of a continuous queue of Dogs in Utes. This record breaking event was held in Corrigin in 2002, broking the Victorians record of 797. (en route to Mwave Rock)

Corrigin is only 235km south-east of Perth, on the Brookton Highway. Situated in the Central Wheatbelt, it is rich in agricultural culture with friendly locals. Along the way you will travel through Jarrah, Marri and Wandoo forests which then open out into the golden wheatland, sheep and cattle farms.

Corrigin was widely known as 'A Town of Windmills' due to the abundant supply of ground water. Almost every home had a windmill until 1960 when the town was supplied with scheme water.



There is a vast array of beautiful and unusual wildflowers, shrubs and trees throughout the year. The Corrigin Wildflower Drive starts at the Dog Cemetery, 5km west on the Brookton Highway and takes you to the Scenic Lookout overlooking the town and wheat bins. Variety is the keynote as the plants change with soils through various woodlands, thickets and shrublands. There are hundreds of different plants, Feather Flowers, Leschenaultias, Grevilleas, Mallets, Smoke Bushes and tall Eucalypts give a fantastic range of colours. The Corrigin Grevillea, *Grevillea scapigera* was feared to be extinct but innovative research and artificial propagation of this critically endangered plant has ensured that it will be preserved for future generations. Spring flowering orchids include Donkeys, Cowslips, Mantis, Blue Beard, Spiders, Shells, Snails and Greenhoods. One that can't be seen is the extremely rare Underground Orchid, *Rhizanthella gardneri*. Days are often spent searching, without reward as this orchid flowers and fruits in the topsoil under leaf litter.
