



50'S FARM SHED

(see reverse map - point 30)

This shed is utilised by the 50's farm group who farm a small amount of donated land the 50's way, using 1950's machinery and knowledge. Drop in and meet the local members who'll happily take you through the working shed.

WATTONING HISTORICAL SITE

A significant historical settlement used for carting water at the turn of the century. The remains of two wells, a gnamma hole, a homestead and three lonely graves remind us of time gone by. Informative signage at this site tells the story of some of the homestead's original occupants and the tragic accounts of the two babies and one early pastoralist buried at Wattoning.

SHIRE OF MUKINBUDIN MAP

GOODCHILD'S GATEWAY

This historic gateway was constructed in 1947 by Stan Goodchild (the owner of the property at that time) in memory of his son Harold, who was killed in action in December 1944 while serving with the RAAF.

UNIQUE BULK GRAIN STORAGE SILO

(see reverse map - point 31)

Built in 1949 by the late Lloyd George (Jack) Jones from local bush timber with only an axe. The Silo has been restored and re-erected in Mukinbudin in recognition of the importance of the grain growing industry to this area. It is also a reminder of the initiative and innovation of our pioneers.

BERINGBOODING ROCK

Wheatbelt Way catchment tank in Australia, holding more than 8.5 million litres. Beringboodding also has an amazing balancing boulder, huge gnamma hole and features ancient Aboriginal paintings in a cave at the rear of the rock.

Great picnic and free camping facilities with easy caravan access, picnic tables, BBQs, a toilet, informative signage and a marked walk trail.

ELACHBUTTING ROCK

Elachbutting Rock has a spectacular colourful wave (rivaling the famous Wave Rock) with the added beauty of 'Monty's Pass', a 30m tunnel caused by a rock slide. An excellent place to camp with BBQs, picnic tables and a toilet. Elachbutting has a reputation for being bigger, better and more pristine than any Wheatbelt granite rock formation that you may have seen before.

HISTORIC BONNIE ROCK TOWNSITE


An historic 1930's townsite with informative Wheatbelt Way signage detailing the town's history. Free camping is permitted and the toilets behind the hall are always open for use.

POPE'S HILL HISTORICAL SITE

Pope's Hill Historical site tells the story of Colonel Harold Pope, John Mulqueeny and the returning soldiers who contributed greatly to the development of farming land in the Lake Brown area, which was the first large scale Soldier Settlement Scheme in Western Australia.

WEIRA RESERVE

This reserve boasts a picturesque limestone breakaway. There is a BBQ, picnic and free camping facilities and a toilet. Native flora and fauna abound. Take a short bush walk to discover the large gnamma hole.



ABOUT MUKINBUDIN

Mukinbudin is a vibrant, rural town located 296 kilometres North East of Perth in the heart of the Eastern Wheatbelt. The population of the shire is approximately 480 and we are renowned for our friendly, welcoming community. The climate is moderate with cool winters and hot summers. Mukinbudin is beautiful all year round with the most popular times to visit being between April and October.

The original occupants of the area now known as Mukinbudin were the Kalamaia group of Aboriginal people. They lived over an area of approximately 88,000 square kilometres stretching between the present day locations of Bullabulling, Kalannie and Youanmi. The present Shire of Mukinbudin was settled by pastoralists who, in the 1870's, took up large leases in excess of 20,000 acres to run sheep, as well as Sandalwood cutters and miners en-route to the goldfields. The main industry in Mukinbudin today is broad-acre crop farming and large scale sheep production for wool and meat.

There are plenty of accommodation options in Mukinbudin including our outstanding caravan park, located adjacent to the swimming pool. The caravan park has a range of accommodation from powered sites to air conditioned, self-contained units and a house. Facilities include excellent shearing shed themed camper's kitchen, brand new clean ablations & BBQ facilities, broadband, internet, RV friendly, town dumpsite available. Caravan park accommodation includes free access to the pool in swimming season.

Mallinig Hill continues around the Golf Course

Visitors to Mukinbudin are requested to bring their own firewood with them when camping at free campsites and in the Caravan Park, as firewood at these locations is sparse. The use of chainsaws is prohibited and vegetation and infrastructure is not to be removed for the purpose of firewood for campfires. Please adhere to prohibited burning periods and safe campfire practices.
