Pensioner Concessions

Western Australian residents in possession of a valid Pensioner card are entitled to a 50% concession on all Transwa services.

Pensioner cards are issued by Centrelink or the Department of Veterans' Affairs. Pensioner concession cardholders will receive four Free Trip Vouchers with their Pensioner card every two years and these may be redeemed to obtain four single journeys or two return journeys on Transwa services prior to the expiry date on the vouchers.

If vouchers have been lost or stolen, replacement vouchers can be issued by Transwa. To apply for replacement vouchers, complete the **Application for Replacement of Free Travel Vouchers for Western Australian Pensioners** form available on transwa.wa.gov.au. Transwa requires a copy of both sides of a valid pension card and will check individual entitlements are still valid before reissuing voucher/s (a fee applies).

Please note:

- To obtain a pensioner SmartRider contact Transperth 13 62 13.
- Only the primary cardholder as named on the card can use the Pensioner card for concessional travel on Transwa services.

Senior Concessions

Seniors nationally are entitled to a 50% concession on all Transwa services; provided they hold valid State Government Seniors Cards for the state in which they live.

Holders of interstate Seniors cards must call Transwa 1300 662 205 or visit a Transwa office to make bookings.

Western Australian Senior SmartRider cards are granted by the Department of Communities to Western Australian residents.
